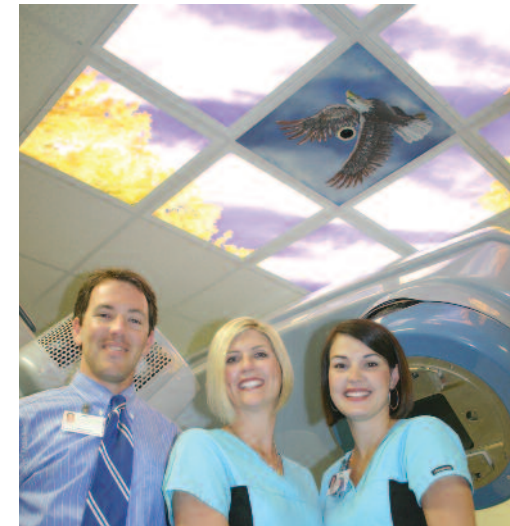

Donations to Heartbeat Program Benefit Tanner Patients and Employees

This year marks the 16th year of Tanner Medical Foundation's Heartbeat Employee Giving program. Tanner team members have raised more than \$1 million through the Heartbeat Employee Giving program through voluntary donations from their paychecks.

Half of each employee's donation goes to the humanitarian fund to assist employees in times of crisis. The other half of the donation goes to either the indigent care fund, cancer care fund or general program/equipment fund, as chosen by the employee.

Over the years, Heartbeat has funded many worthwhile programs and projects benefiting Tanner patients and employees. In addition, hundreds of employees have been assisted through the humanitarian fund with crises ranging from a devastating house fire to a tragic accident or illness in the family.

Humanitarian Fund

Assists team members with family crises

The Heartbeat humanitarian fund provides a way for employees to help when a co-worker experiences an unexpected crisis. Over the years, employees have been assisted when they (or their spouses) experienced devastating crises such as house fires, serious accidents or prolonged illness. This year's Heartbeat humanitarian fund took on special significance when it assisted Tanner team members with the devastating floods that occurred in our area.

To date this year, 26 employees from different hospitals and departments were assisted through the Heartbeat humanitarian fund.

Last year, Amanda Jones, a nurse in Tanner Medical Center/Carrollton's radiology department and her husband, Chris, were thrilled when they found out they were expecting twins. Her first six months of the pregnancy came easy. However, during her 27th week, Amanda's husband unexpectedly lost his job when the company he worked for filed for bankruptcy.

With Amanda serving as the sole provider for the family, she struggled to come in every day to cover her shifts as her pregnancy became more

of a burden on her body. At 31 weeks, the strain became too much and she went into pre-term labor. Her doctor ordered bed rest. "Because I had to save up my extended leave for when the twins arrived, I was out of work without pay. My husband and I had no income for a while – this was a very scary feeling," says Amanda.

"I applied and received the funding. It paid a month worth of our bills and kept us from getting behind. It was such a blessing to have such wonderful people supporting me through the difficult time we were going through," she continues.

The twins, Calley and Hunter, were born at 35 weeks. "Tanner employees are like family. The camaraderie between us is very strong and we do whatever we can to help one another and the patients and families we serve."

Holiday Assistance Program

Assists nominated team members during the holidays

In November of each year, Tanner departments are invited to nominate an employee to receive a \$100 grocery gift certificate through the Heartbeat Holiday Assistance program. Each department within Tanner Health System may nominate one employee (you may nominate an employee outside of your department) who is experiencing hardships from everyday life and would benefit from a gift of groceries. In 2008, 90 employees were nominated and each received a \$100 grocery gift certificate in December. Nomination forms will be e-mailed to department directors by mid-November. The deadline for nominations is December 1, 2009. ❤️



Indigent Care Fund

Assists with Patient Medications

Some Heartbeat donors choose to support the indigent care fund through the second half of their donation. This fund was established primarily to assist patients who are unable to afford their medications upon discharge from the hospital, many of whom suffer from chronic diseases. The case management departments for each hospital handles the applications for assistance from the indigent care fund.

This year, about six patients per month were assisted with their medications upon discharge from the hospital and patients were assisted with transportation to and from the hospital through a taxi fund. In addition, the indigent care fund provides cardiac rehabilitation to patients who are unable to afford the three-phase program. This year, two patients were enrolled in cardiac rehab through the Heartbeat indigent care fund. ❤️

General Program/Equipment Fund

Many employees support the general program/equipment fund with the second half of their Heartbeat donations. This fund provides non-budgeted programs and equipment that will enhance patient care and/or make the employee's job easier. Since the start of the Heartbeat Employee Giving program in 1993, 258 pieces of equipment ranging from blanket warmers to phlebotomy draw chairs, totaling more than \$344,000, has been donated by employees to improve the services that Tanner provides for patients and their families.

The Tanner Medical Center/Carrollton committee approved seven equipment requests from four departments this year.

The following equipment was purchased in 2009:

- Pediatrics – underwear, socks, DVDs, activities for children in hospital
- Ultrasound – three ultrasound gel warmers
- Infusion Center – two portable DVD players, movies, disposable headsets and a privacy screen
- 3 East – hygiene supplies to assist with patient care

The Tanner Medical Center/Villa Rica committee approved eight equipment requests from five departments this year.

The following equipment was purchased in 2009:

- ICU – turbo thermometer to check patient temperatures and a Sigma Smart infusion pump
- ER - adult intraosseous needle gun and a fetal heart monitor
- Labor and Delivery – AccuCheck machine
- Ultrasound – Gel warmer
- Tanner Breast Health – micro-cut shredder

The Higgins General Hospital Heartbeat committee received three equipment applications from four departments during 2009.

The following equipment was purchased in 2009:

- Tanner Health Source in Bremen – treadmill for employee workout area
- Physical Therapy – Skyscapes light cover
- Administration - wheelchairs

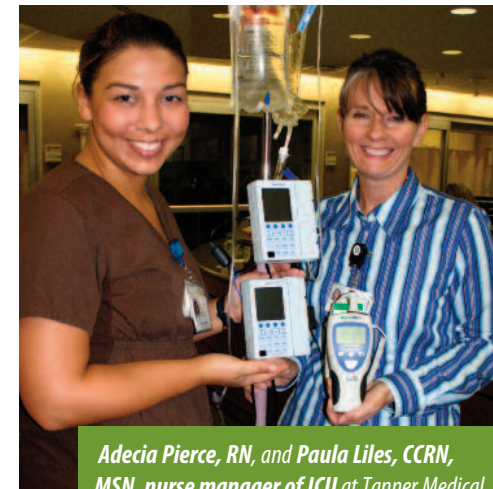
