Jack Threadgill: A Public Servant at Heart

The following article was written prior to Mr. Jack Threadgill's passing on Feb. 24, 2010. Tanner Hospice Care expresses the deepest sympathy to Mrs. Mary Threadgill and her family.

For most of his life, Jack Threadgill, who's almost 80, has been concerned about helping others. As one of the first certified public accountants in Carroll County, he helped

described him as a calm, peaceful and very intelligent public servant with a strong faith in God.

Reflecting on their lives together, Mary said, "I'll just start from when I moved to Carrollton – on my 9th birthday. Jack and I lived next door to one another. Our parents became good friends and we went to the same schools."

Once Jack graduated from high school, the couple parted ways. Jack was attending West Georgia College when his Air Force reserve unit called him to serve in Nashville, TN. It was there that he was a passenger in a one-car accident, suffering severe head and facial injuries. He was taken to a military hospital in Montgomery, AL. He received treatment there for almost a year.

When he was released from the hospital, he entered Georgia State University and worked at the downtown Atlanta post office. At the Atlanta post office, he met his first wife, Helen. They had four children together; Kathy, John, Jack Jr. and Diane. Helen died suddenly in 1977.

Jack and Mary reunited and were married in April, 1978. Mary and her son, Chris, joined Jack and his children. The couple has now been married for almost 32 years.

"My family and his were always very good friends," said Mary. "In fact, we had brothers who were born in the same year and on the same day. When my mother found out we were going to join the families, she was the happiest I have ever seen her."

When Jack finished at Georgia State, he worked for an accounting firm in Atlanta. The firm decided to open an office in another city and Jack offered to open the office in Carrollton. As the business grew, Jimmy Garrett became a partner. The original Atlanta partners were bought out and the name of the firm was changed to Threadgill & Garrett, CPAs.

"I don't know how he's been able to do all he has done," says Mary. She smiles as she looks out the window onto the water. "The way I've always described him is similar to one of these geese. He is very calm and peaceful on the surface, but like the feet of the geese – going all the time – Jack's brain was always working."

When he was diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease in 2004, the doctors confirmed that the severe head injury Jack suffered in the car accident when he was young caused the problems he is now experiencing.

In September and October of last year, he spent five weeks in the hospital.

"His condition was deteriorating," said Mary. "His doctor mentioned moving him to a nursing home and I said 'no, I'm sorry, I want to take him home.'"

Jack's doctor said that Mary could take him home, only if she would agree to bring in hospice care.

In October, Jack became a patient of Tanner Hospice Care.

"I cannot say enough good things about Tanner Hospice Care," said Mary. "Everyone has been wonderful and available 24-hours a day, seven-days-a-week. Chaplain Jimmy Bryan has been very supportive along with the nurses and other caregivers of Tanner Hospice Care."

Jack's family is pleased that his quality of life has been improved because of Tanner Hospice Care.

Mary and Jack's son, Chris Cunningham, has been heavily involved in helping his mother.

"I really appreciate all that Tanner Hospice Care has done for both my parents," said Chris. "They have not only provided excellent care to Jack, but have also been willing to sit with my Mom to discuss Jack's disease and to talk to her about the changes he is experiencing. I can't express enough my appreciation for all Tanner Hospice Care has done for my family."

These days, Jack is still caring for those around him.

"Jack never complains – he cares about his hospice caregivers and tells them 'thank you,'" comments Mary. "He will never change – he is still a gentleman and he cares about everyone around him. His heart is as pure as a heart can be. Our community is fortunate to have Tanner Hospice Care." 🍀
